

<u>The Big Lift</u>

Looking for something to do on Sunday, 8th July, come and meet the students and give a hand at the school or golf club.

The Big Lift is a student-led organisation founded with the philosophy of 'paying it forward' and giving back to the community.

In their 2016 visit, The Big Lift was involved in Wyangala Dam Public School with gardening, planting, moving and spreading mulch and shifting debris.

Similar to that year, they offer us the service of <u>40 student</u> <u>volunteers</u> for half a day as they spend the afternoon to travel to the next town. They will be able to do projects that the town needs to be completed such as painting, gardening, cleaning and simple construction projects with unskilled labour. —half of the students will be at the school and the other half at the Golf Club.

In return for their volunteer services we have organised with Reflections Holiday Park Wyangala Waters that the hall be used as accommodation for one night - the volunteers are required to bring their own sleeping gear (sleeping bag/mat). We are also providing them with a meal at the Wyangala Country Club on the Saturday night! By doing this it helps to keep the costs down for their volunteers, allowing them to visit more towns each year.

Their estimated arrival time is 3.30pm, then they will unpack at Reflections Holiday Park Wyangala Waters and conduct a Scavenger Hunt activity that will eventually lead them to Wyangala Country Club around 6.30pm for dinner. They would like to talk to people about the town and its history before dinner, if you are available please come and share your knowledge.
