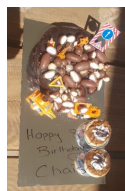

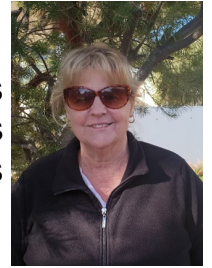

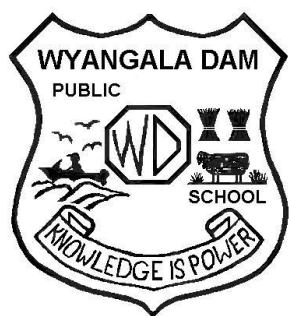


Friday, is fun day with Mrs Carter, and included Library, Dance, feeding the worms, PDH, and FUN!

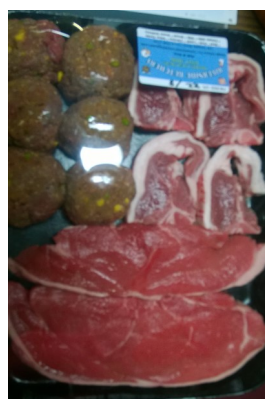

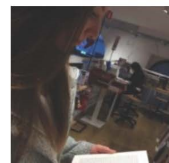
